Knowledge of Environmental Processes and Systems

Grade: 9-12 English

Standard:

A.12.1-12.5- Students will identify a current environmental problem cited in scientific literature or the media. While maintaining a historical perspective, students will investigate the current problem and propose possible further research and critique other students' proposals. Students will communicate the results of their investigation to groups concerned with the issue.

Sample Activity:

Identify and research an environmental problem, propose possible further research then critique other students' works, and communicate results with groups concerned with the issue.

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B.12.17 and B.12.20- Students will explain the idea of exported and imported pollution and debate the risks of those pollutants.

Sample Activity:

Review provided articles and debate the risks of pollutants and the tradings of these imports and exports that can cause pollutants.
